Proper nutrition plays a key role in our pet’s whole health – body, mind and behavior. Compare pet nutritional requirements to the nutritional needs of humans and similar profiles emerge. Lack of meeting these requirements leads to learning difficulties, certain behavioral problems, breakdowns of cellular and organ functions generally, a decreased quality of life and further, increased cost of health care, much of which can be avoided when wise choices are considered.

Our pets depend on us to interpret food labels and make informed decisions that increase their healthy longevity and enhanced learning potential. They too, need a balance of protein, carbohydrates, vitamins, minerals and essential fatty acids that will sustain them in their daily activities. Until strict quality control, including food labeling, is a totally accepted practice in the pet food industry, there exists a risk of imbalance or lack of EFA’s and therefore requires much self-education. In the process, many products required for their nutrient content may be reduced as a cost saving measure.



Fats are controversial ingredient in all diets. Fat provides the body with a needed source of energy as well as support for neurological functions. It is the type of fat that we must be conscious of when feeding our pets. Many vegetable fats are broken down into fatty acids that are essential for maintaining skin and coat health. It is the essential fatty acids that have been neglected and need important focus. The fatty acid families, Omega 6 (Linoleic Acid) and Omega 3 (Alpha Linolenic Acid) cannot be manufactured by the body, therefore must be added to the food ingredients or supplemented by a properly balanced food product are deemed essential. Few commercially prepared foods include the proper balance. Lack of, or incorrect balance of these may lead to deficiencies in skin and coat condition, blood health, cardiovascular health and heart function, hormonal function, organ function, immunity, energy and metabolic levels, behavior and mental conditions and joint health. Cell membranes must receive support from essential fatty acids. This is health at the cellular level! Cells are where the passage of nutrients, water and wastes are regulated. Cells are where the production of energy occurs.

The Omega 3 family is responsible for brain and eye tissue function, while the Omega 6 family is responsible for maintaining coat and skin, growth, structure of cell membranes, distributing fat soluble vitamins (such as A, D, E and K). Essential Fatty Acid ingredients in pet food must be questioned; any level of processing heat, light, and oxygen, compromises the freshness and effectiveness of these ingredients. Several oils together in acceptable balance are required for optimal nutrition. An acceptable balance generally agreed upon by researches is a ratio of 10:1 to 5:1 (omega 6; omega 3). These may include combinations of flax, sunflower, sesame and fish. But, the “only” natural oil by itself that provides a favorable balance is Hemp Seed Oil in a 3:1 ratio. This ratio adds a little more Omega 3, which may make up for the storage in food ingredients. Hemp requires no herbicides or pesticides for growth. Not only does Hemp Seed Oil provide health benefits, but also the growing of Hemp is cost-competitive and holds important environmental benefits.
